Greetings! Volunteers have been a huge part of the success of the Market and we want your time to be enjoyable and fulfilling.

Moss Street Market operates every Saturday, May through October from 10am – 2pm. You do not have to volunteer every Saturday.

The setting is outdoors in all weather. We have a Winter Market the other 6 months, but it does not require volunteers.

If you sign up to be a volunteer, we would prefer you come more than once as our training time is limited the day of the Market. Please fill out the Volunteer Application form first. Occasionally, people show up the day of the Market wanting to volunteer, but we already have filled the positions and the potential volunteers are disappointed.

Volunteer roles at the Market:

SET-UP: 8:00am – 10am
Requires some lifting, but we help each other. Very important, since we need to be done before the 10am bell which starts the Market.

GREEN TEAM: 11am – 1pm
1pm – 3pm Helps with Tear-Down
Help customers decide if they need to use the compost, recycle or garbage receptacles.

INFORMATION TENT: 10am – 12pm
12pm – 2pm Very helpful if this shift stays to help with tear-down
Supply information to customers about vendors, activities and other Market information. There is an information sheet with answers to the most frequent questions.

VENDOR SERVICE: 11am – 1pm
This person goes to booths which only have one vendor and offers to get them lunch, coffee, etc. Occasionally, after the vendors are familiar with the Volunteer, the vendor may ask the Volunteer to watch their booth so they can go to the washroom or take a short break.

TEAR-DOWN: 2pm – 3pm
Requires some lifting, but we help each other. Very helpful, as the staff is pretty tired by then.
